





# Autumn One: Holiday Homework Y1



Maths	English	Reading
<p>In year 1, we have been practising adding and taking away using a number line like this one, showing <math>8-3 = 5</math>. Practise taking away within 20 by drawing your own number line. See how many different sums you can make!</p>  <p><b>Challenge:</b> How many ways can you make the answer of 5 using addition and subtraction?</p>	<p>This half term we read "Traction Man" in Year 1. Now, can you write your own version of "Traction Man"? Remember to include a setting, a problem and a resolution in your story. Also include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Capital Letters and full stops</li> <li>- Finger spaces between words</li> <li>- Conjunctions (and, but, so, because)</li> <li>- Descriptions</li> </ul>	<p>In year 1 we have been practicing our phonics, and blending and segmenting our sounds. Recently, we learned words with these sounds:</p> <p>-er -ur -ee -oa -oi -or -igh -air -ire</p> <p>Can you go on a phonics hunt? See if you can find as many words as you can with these sounds!</p>
