




# Autumn One: Holiday Homework Y2

<p>This half term, we have been focussing on adding and subtracting. We have been using dienes and counters to help us, as well as formal methods like the one shown on the right. Use some dice to make up your own numbers to keep practising this method.</p> $\begin{array}{r} 59 \\ -43 \\ \hline 16 \end{array}$ <p><b>Challenge:</b> Can you try a question which requires renaming, for example 51 – 29? Can you show what this would look like in a picture?</p>	<p>This half term, we read "On Sudden Hill" in Year 2. We've been thinking about how the characters might have felt. Can you write a diary entry from Birt's point of view? Remember to include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Capital Letters and full stops</li> <li>- Finger spaces between words</li> <li>- Conjunctions (and, but, so, because)</li> <li>- Descriptions of your feelings</li> </ul>	<p>In year 2 we have been practicing our phonics, as well as developing our comprehension skills. Recently, we learned words with these sounds:</p> <p style="text-align: center;">-er -ur -ee -oa -oi -or</p> <p>Can you go on a phonics hunt? See if you can find as many words as you can with these sounds!</p> <p>To practise your comprehension skills, read a book with an adult. Can you discuss what you are reading, make predictions and summarise the story?</p>

Where is all of the furniture? Can you use a "birds eye view" like we discussed in class?</p> 	<p>Year 2 have been learning about Joan Miro, and his bold, geometric lines and colours. Can you create a piece of artwork inspired by Miro?</p>
